Lot No. 301 Presented by Stuart Wardle, The Durham Fly Fishing Company

Guide Price £350 (Start Price £250)

One day for one rod guided by Stuart Wardle fishing for trout and grayling on a northern river (**Swale, Tees, Eden** etc.). Stuart is a qualified professional guide & owner of The Durham Fly Fishing Company based in County Durham and he will share his enthusiasm for fly fishing these wonderful northern rivers. Waders and tackle can be provided. Date by agreement, 2017 season. Proceeds will be dedicated to habitat work with the Wear Rivers Trust.

Lot No. 302 Presented by the Bordogan Estate

Guide Price £50 (Starting Price £25)

One day for 2 rods or two days for 1 rod, trout fishing on the beautiful **Llyn Coron** by Aberffraw on the Isle of Anglesey. Bank fishing, easy wading or float tubes permitted. This unusual lowland lake is naturally nutrient rich and set amongst sand dunes which are a Special Area of Conservation (SAC). The lake contains a good stock of brown trout and enjoys a run of sea-trout, depending on conditions. Llyn Coron featured in an article by Jon Beer in Trout & Salmon magazine. The Estate Manager will show the winning bidder the fishing on arrival. 2017 season.

Lot No. 303 Presented by the Ferryhill and District Angling Club

A guided day for two rods, fishing for salmon and /or sea trout on the Burn Hall beat of the River Wear near Durham. September or October 2017. Proceeds will be dedicated to habitat work with the Wear Rivers Trust.

Lot No. 304 Presented by the Tichborne Syndicate

Guide Price £150 (Starting Price £75)

One day for 1 rod to fish the Tichborne Syndicate's water on the Tichborne (Cheriton Stream), one of the headwaters of the River Itchen. This 2-mile beat is lightly fished and presents challenging but rewarding fishing for the wild trout enthusiast in gin-clear water. This intimate small chalk stream is exclusively populated by wild trout, mainly under the pound mark, with the occasional larger fish. The Syndicate manages the beat sensitively. Wading within the stream is necessary to exploit its potential fully, so bring chest waders, light tackle and a stealthy approach. Upstream dry fly or nymph, barbless or de-barbed hooks, catch & release only. A member of the Syndicate will introduce you to the beat on the day and provide guiding to the level desired. Best fished in late May / early June depending on water levels. Date by arrangement during the 2017 season.
