The UK River Prize is back this year, once again providing the opportunity for you to showcase and receive recognition for your river restoration project.

The 2016 winner will be announced on 26th April at the UK River Prize Awards Dinner in the Imperial Hotel, Blackpool. This coincides with the RRC's Annual Network Conference which is held in the same venue on the 26th & 27th April.

UK River Prize Categories

Anyone from a range of sectors who are involved in projects of different scales can apply, as the applications are judged across four categories.

- Catchment scale project
- Stand-alone project
- Partnership project
- Multiple benefit project

The winner of each of these categories becomes a finalist and will have a chance of winning the Nigel Holmes Trophy and £10,000 prize at the River Prize Awards Dinner.
